Introduction

The Albertine Rift Conservation Society (ARCOS) is implementing a five-year (2023-2028) project entitled "*Landscape Restoration for Sustainable Socio-Ecological Systems and Resilience to Climate Change project*" also known as Kivu- Rusizi Catchment Restoration (KiRuCaRe) project, with financial support from Bezos Earth Fund. The project's goal is to engage 9,000 households by empowering local actors in restoration efforts across Rwanda, Burundi, and the DRC. The project aims to create three (3) model landscape restoration learning sites around Lake Kivu- river Rusizi basin, and to facilitate 100 Friends of Nature Associations (FNAs) access finance for nature-based solution implementation. In DRC, the project will be implemented through collaboration with two NGOs member of the Africa NGOs Alliance for Environmental Sustainability (ANAES), Association Burundaise pour la protection de la Nature (ABN) and Réseau DRC 2000 Plus (RBU2000+) to host project staff and support in the local project implementation.

Purpose of the Position

The Project Officer will support the implementation KiRuCaRe project, focusing on field activities at the learning model sites in DRC. He/she will ensure effective delivery of project objectives through community engagement, technical support, monitoring, and reporting.

Key Responsibilities

1. Facilitate the establishment and operationalization of integrated landscape restoration learning site
2. Support the formation and capacity building Friends of Nature Associations (FNAs).

3. Provide technical assistance to community structures, cooperatives, and committees to ensure their active participation in project activities.
4. Promote community awareness on sustainable land management, tree planting, and restoration practices.
5. Assist in training sessions on tree nursery management, tree planting techniques, and ecosystem restoration.
6. Provide guidance to local communities to ensure alignment with project goals.
7. Conduct regular data collection on project implementation progress at learning sites.
8. Prepare monthly updates, quarterly technical reports, and financial reports
9. Support ARCOS in organizing national or regional workshops and conferences in DRC.

Required Qualifications

- ✓ Master's or Bachelor's degree in conservation, natural resource management, environmental planning, agriculture or a related field.
- ✓ At least 3 years of experience managing environment or natural resource management projects at a senior level.
- ✓ Proven track record working with government officials, civil society organizations, and community groups.
